Governor Malloy has proposed a state budget that asks too much from hardworking middle-class families, including state workers. Eliminating the \$500 property tax credit and requiring massive concessions will hurt working families across Connecticut.

But big multi-state corporations are still getting tax loopholes and subsidies that allow them to avoid paying ANY state taxes. And the wealthiest are still being asked to pay their fair share towards our state future (*they pay only 4.9% of their income in state and local taxes while middle-class families pay almost 10%!*)

The State Legislature is working now to pass its own budget proposal. We need to tell our State Senators and Representatives to pass a better budget—closing corporate loopholes and raising more revenue from the wealthiest individuals, who can best afford it. This will eliminate the ‘need’ to take away so much from middle-class families.

April 27 is the deadline for the Legislature’s Finance Committee to pass a better budget tax/revenue proposal, so we need to act now!
